Code of Ethics (Club Policy)

Purpose of the Club: Founded in 1988 as an affiliate of the American Association for Nude Recreation (formerly the American Sunbathing Association) to express our belief in the unimpeded right to practice Social Family Nudism.

1. Non compliance with Club Bylaws or Code of Ethics can result in suspension of membership or revocation of membership at the discretion of the Board of Directors. In cases of the violation of the laws of the land, the police may be contacted.
2. WE ABSOLUTELY WILL NOT TOLERATE ANY QUESTIONABLE ACTIONS WITH REGARD TO CHILDREN. IF THERE IS ANY DOUBT AS TO YOUR MOTIVES WITH THE CHILDREN, WE WILL ACT FIRST & ASK QUESTIONS LATER. REMEMBER THIS, SOMEONE IS WATCHING YOU AT ALL TIMES.
3. While the purpose of some organizations is to offer recreational sex, NFN does not. We do acknowledge sexuality as being healthy but we do not believe that club functions are a proper environment for this activity. No public or open sexual contact nor lewd behavior will be tolerated. Hugs between friends are fine.
4. No vulgarity or profane language as is objected to in common practice will be tolerated. Remember, some members have young children and most adults don't care to hear bad language either.
5. The use of non prescription drugs or controlled substances will not be tolerated. This rule shall also extend to the overt use of prescription drugs if behavior problems should develop as a result thereof.
6. Excessive drunkenness will not be tolerated. We may drink only as long as we can behave ourselves.
7. Smoking is permitted at outside functions at the discretion of the host/hostess. Meetings held inside are smoke free.
8. Aggravated, demeaning, hostile or overtly aggressive behavior will not be tolerated. No wrestling, fighting, or rude behavior. Treat others as you would like to be treated.
9. Nudists come from all walks of life and are the most open minded of people. Racial, ethnic or sexist slurs and/or harassment will not be tolerated.
10. Photographs, video and audio recordings are the reserved responsibility of the historian and by special permission from each individual being photographed. Secretly taken photographs will not be tolerated; we will confiscate the film. If you bring a camera, please respect others' privacy or you will be asked to put it away. Everyone is not comfortable being photographed nude, especially "first timers." Remember your first time?
11. Last names and business phone numbers should be considered private. The use or selling of club membership for mailing lists will not be tolerated. There is still a problem with prejudice against the nudist community by those who are uninformed. This issue is being addressed by AANR through public relations, but is still a problem in the workplace for some members.

12. Guests who behave themselves are welcome. Members inviting guest(s) are responsible in all ways for that (those) guest(s). Be sure they know the rules as well as the etiquette so they won't be embarrassed. They (and we) will feel more comfortable if they understand the basics (eye contact, sit on your own towel, obey host rules, etc.). Remember, they probably don't know quite what to expect in spite of all the times you told them how great nudists are.
13. All events and activities are to be clothing optional unless otherwise specified.
14. The carrying of guns, knives or any overtly or potentially dangerous item will not be tolerated. Permitted defense weapons are well and good, but that permit will not bring back a lost friend should there be an accident. Please leave them home or locked in your vehicle; we are a peaceful bunch.
15. Needless to say, theft or use of others' personal items without permission will not be tolerated.
16. Our hosts and hostesses will have the right to outline their own house rules. They are to be obeyed to the letter. This will extend to the rules and/or policy of clubs whose grounds or meetings we may visit.
17. For hygienic reasons, when nude, sit on your own towel or personal piece of clothing. If you have come without yours (this does happen occasionally since we are all human) ask the host or hostess if you might borrow one for the event.
18. Members are responsible for their own financial obligations to- NFN, FANR, AANR, other Clubs and to each other. Please do not expect the Board to attend to any of these matters for you.
19. The NFN, its members and/or host(s) will not be held responsible or liable for any injury or accidents at club functions.
20. We strive for an "au naturale" atmosphere so be yourself and have fun. These rules are not restrictive, just comprehensive. You can believe that this group has plenty of fun within these guidelines.
